Hop River State Park Trail

- The original railroad - built in 1849 – operated for 100 years.
- The abandoned railway bed running between Manchester and Willimantic was regraded in several phases between 1994 – 2004 with funding from local, state, and federal grants.
- 5-miles of the 21-mile **Hop River State Park** rail trail passes through the town of Vernon.
- The **State of CT Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP)** maintain this section of rail trail.
- The **Hop River Trail** connects to the **Air Line State Park Trail** in Willimantic, providing an additional 50 miles of rail trail in eastern Connecticut.

Rockville Spur

- The **Rockville Spur** splits from the **Hop River State Park Trail** at Phoenix Street, east of the Church Street parking lot.
- The **Spur** extends 4.25-miles toward the historic center of Rockville.
- This railroad bed was originally constructed in 1862 to supply the thriving mill industries in Rockville.
- The trail passes over the Tankerhoosen River and under I-84, where a mural can be viewed.

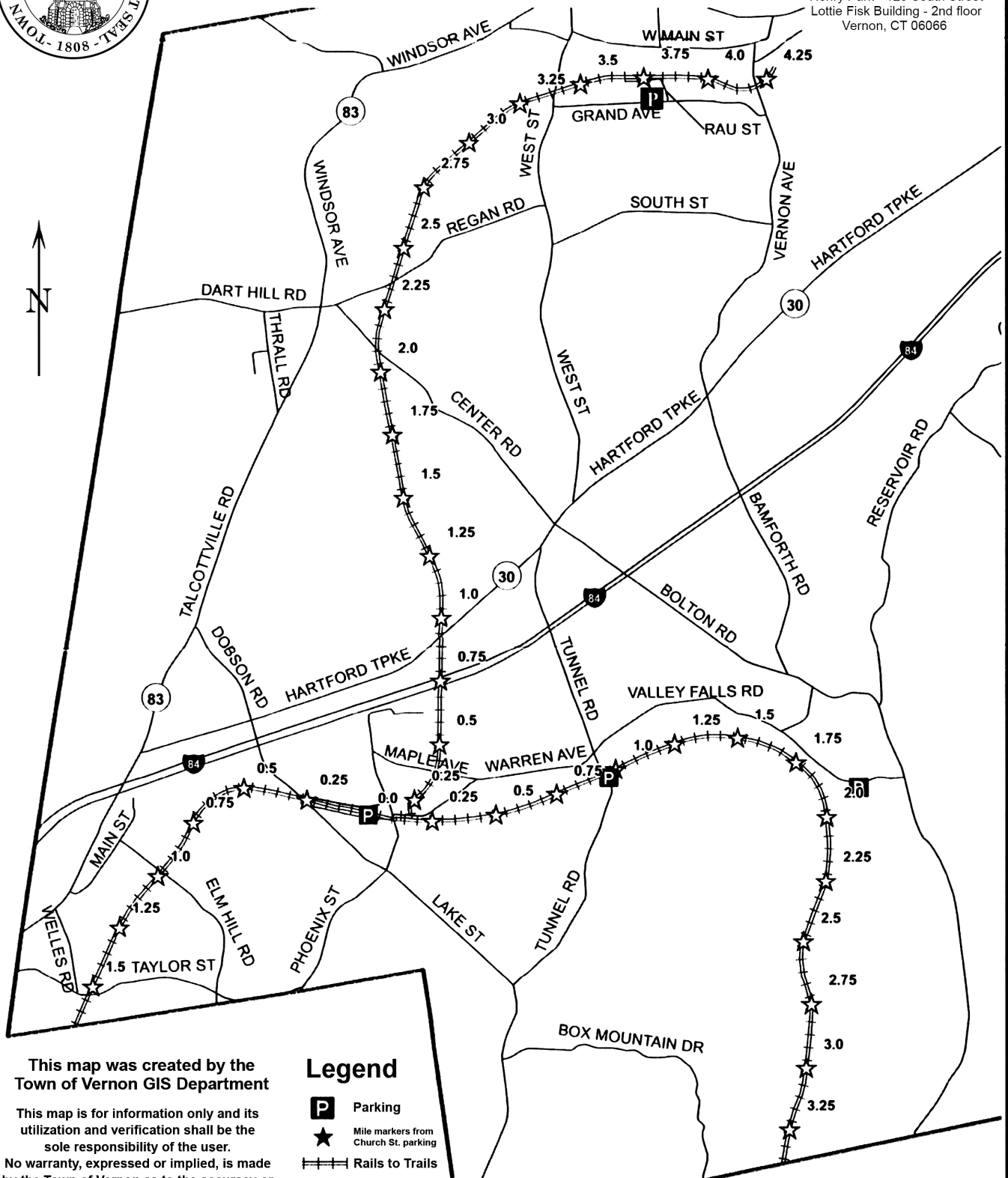
